

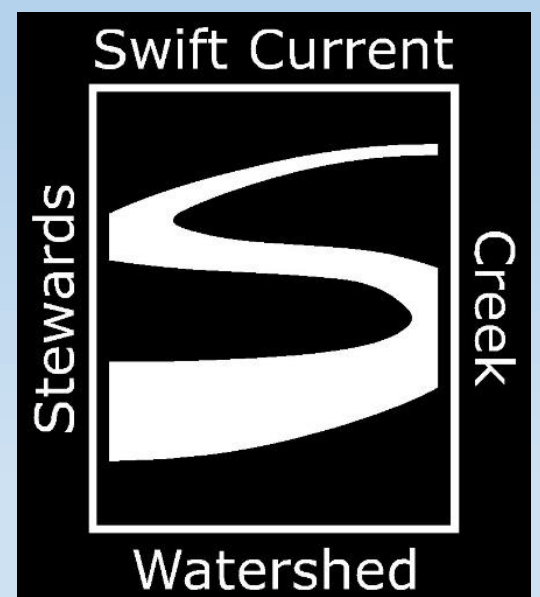

Watersheds, Eh?

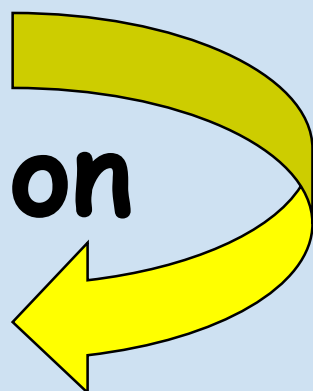
If I got \$500
