Some plants are in the water and are called aquatic plants.

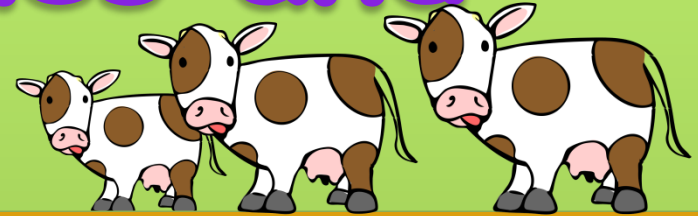
The plants help keep out all the dirt and pollutants that could get into the creek.

Riparian zones and agriculture can work together with good management from farmers!

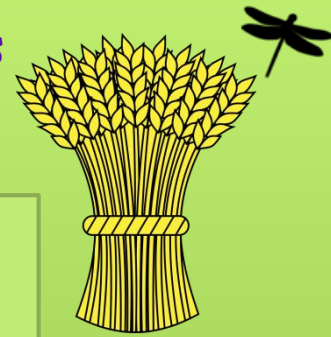

How many dragonflies can you find?

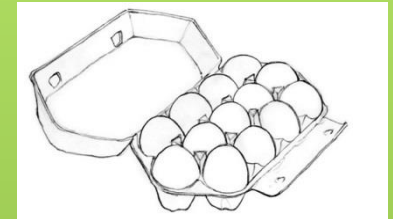


What kinds of crops are grown in Saskatchewan?
